# **Transparency Code for Smaller Councils**

The Transparency Code for Smaller Councils requires the parish council to publish the following information:

- All items of expenditure above £100
- End of year accounts, the annual governance statement and the internal audit report
- A list of councillor responsibilities
- Details of public land and building assets owned by the parish council
- Draft minutes should be published not later than a month following the meeting
- Agendas should be published not later than 3 clear days before the meeting is taking place
