40mph Speed Limit

B3257 - from a point 62 metres north-west of the southern access to Trenthorne

to a point 65 metres south-east of its junction with Liskeard Road. **Launceston**

Road - from its junction with Bodmin Road for a distance of 95 metres in a north-easterly direction. **Liskeard Road** - from its junction with Langston Hill for a

distance of 130 metres in a south-westerly direction.
