

The Parish Council held a virtual meeting on 16th March, this meeting was dogged with IT issues but we managed to get through it. We are all looking forward to being able to hold "actual meetings" when we come out of Covid restrictions.

lewannickpc.org.uk.The play areas in Lewannick and Polyphant are going to be cleaned and treated on the 6th April, whilst this is being done we will have to close both areas for a period of 24hrs.

On 6th May we are having local and Parish Council elections. Anyone who wants to stand for Council will need to request nomination papers from Cornwall Council, the link is on the PC web site. There is an election timetable which sets out all the relevant dates. The last day for nomination papers to be handed in is 8th April so why not have a go.
