



PARISH COUNCIL

The Parish Council met in Lewannick village hall on 20/7/21. This was the first full Council meeting after some Covid restrictions had been lifted, it was still preferred that masks should be worn and social distancing adhered to. Our County Councillor reported that Cornwall Council is carrying out a review of Town and Parish Councils thoughts on how the authority works for them. All comments on the virtual footpath by Burnt Oak would have been received by 30/7/21. The branches scattered around the outside St Martins Close have been reported to Cornwall Council and the Environment Officer, BIFFA have been requested to remove the debris.

It has been proposed that the Telephone kiosk on the Polyphant Green be used as a library along with the current information place, the library will be run by a local resident. The telephone kiosk "K6" was adopted by the Council in 2015, it is also a listed structure. The kiosk is in need of a paint job, the paint is being sourced by the Clerk. Cllr Hobden raise concerns about the condition of a path at the top of Polyphant Green, this is an un-adopted road which leads to two properties, it was agreed that this is common land and the Parish Council is not liable and cannot get involved. Play Parks: - a donation was gratefully received for tree works to be carried out in Lewannick, the fencing has been repaired and the area is clean and tidy. Polyphant Park has also had the fence repaired and the trees cut back and the snake rocker has been repainted. The proposal of rewilding of part of Polyphant Green has been moved to the next meeting to allow more information to be gathered.
