PARISH COUNCIL

There was a meeting on 15th March in Lewannick. Adrian Parsons reported that Cornwall Council had voted in £59 Million cuts across every department, cuts include care packages for many elderly, Childrens social work and family support jobs, food waste collections have been delayed for a year and the Climate change budget. He also informed us that the Ships and Castles Leisure centre in Falmouth will close and he is hopeful that a provider will be found to take on Launceston leisure centre. The Clerk had written to the Academy about the fencing off the Hard play area, there has been no reply as yet so it was proposed that we send a letter to the Academy CEO. As there has been no response for volunteers to paint the telephone box (mini Library) in Polyphant we will approach a contractor who has provided a quote to do the work, once the painting has been done we will have an official opening ceremony. The Queens jubilee event will take place over the days of 2/6/22 to 5/6/22 with the Beacon being lit on Thursday, a soft play event for the children on Saturday in Lewannick Village Hall, a big Lunch will be held in Lewannick and Polyphant on Sunday 5th June, there will be a walk from Polyphant Chapel to Lewannick Church on Friday 3rd June. The Council are having commemorative coins made for all the children in the Parish, if you could please register your child with the clerk. The Council have also deferred the Local Council award scheme. The next meeting will be In Lewannick on 19th April at 7.30 pm.
