PARISH COUNCIL

The Council had a meeting in Lewannick Village hall on Tuesday 21st June. Councillor White took the opportunity to thank all those who made the Platinum jubilee events such a success, those that organised and contributed to the soft play, the organisers of both big lunches, to the Churches for their teas and cake and also the flower arrangers, to the organisers of the walk between the two villages and those who helped with the distribution of the commemorative coins thanks also go to the BBQ at the lighting of the Beacon event. Councillor Parsons reported that housing remains a problem, in the past 12 months the numbers of people living in temporary accommodation has risen from 10,000 to 15,000. People are living in Travel lodges or Holiday parks. His full report can be found on his Councillor facebook account.
