PARISH COUNCIL

The Parish Council met on Tuesday 20th Febuary in Lewannick. Cllr Parsons sent in a report which will be available on his official Facebook page. Planning, PA23/09933 Meadowside, Plusha. listed building consent for the replacement of double-glazed windows supported. PA24/00690, Land east of Kerenza at Trenhorne proposed two storey development, workshop, parking and garage, supported. PA24/00979, Methodist Church Polyphant, works to two trees with TPO's supported. Lewannick play park, the Zip wire is showing signs of wear at the head of the wire, this has been taken out of use awaiting an inspection and if needed a repair. The witches hat will not rotate, this has been reported to Schoolscape and we are awaiting an inspection to see if it can be repaired. Polyphant play park, the upgrade to the fencing will be undertaken when the weather improves, whilst the work is being done the Play park will be closed for H&S. A "No Parking" sign has been ordered to place on the Green where there is an issue with inconsiderate parking, parking on the Green is not permitted for many reasons but primarily because the Green has protected status as an area of great scientific interest and there rare Orchids growing. There is a consultation on the transfer of the Duchy Trust Schools into An Daras Trust. Duchy Trust consists of Callington Primary, Lewannick Primary and Boyton Primary. An Daras Trust has been in existence since 2014 and operates eight Primary Schools. The consultation is for five weeks and will conclude prior to any final decision. We discussed registering our involvement in the D-Day Beacon on the 6th June 2024, more information will follow.
