PARISH COUNCIL

The internal Auditor report was circulated to Councillors, and it was proposed to accept, there were no issues raised by the Auditor. The Annual Governance statement 2023/24. It was resolved that this is an accurate statement and that it should be signed and submitted. **Notice of the Exercise of Public Rights, AGAR 2023/24.** The dates of the rights will be published on 19th June and will run from the 20th of June to the 31st July inclusive. **Unitary Councillors Report;** due to purdah there is not much news from Cornwall Council. The extreme wet weather of the last year has had a significantly bad affect on the roads and claims for compensation have risen by 550% with 532% of claims being successful. The Cabinet has resolved to purchase fifty homes for temporary accommodation; currently there are over 800 people in emergency accommodation in Cornwall.

Planning; PA24/03878 & PA24/03620 were both supported. More details of all planning applications can be found on the Cornwall Council web site.

Matters Arising from the above Minutes. It was agreed that when the date is set for the Plusha Junction meeting with National Highways the Clerk will liaise with the other concerned parishes and set up a meeting so that a co-ordinated response can be put together. **Parish Matters:** the Lewannick telephone box is in need of maintenance we are sourcing some paint and will arrange for the door to be repaired, we will also have the brambles removed from the back of the kiosk. **Play areas;** it was agreed to make the payment to Schoolscapes for the repairs at Lewannick Play Park, as read out by the Chairman, £3923.23. The fence between the toddler and junior area will be removed to generate more space when necessary.
