PARISH COUNCIL

At the recent Annual Parish Council meeting held on 20th May, Councillor Michael White was re-elected as Chairman of the Parish Council. Cornwall Councillor, Adrian Parsons thanked everyone for their help and support in the run up and during the elections. He has attended the mandatory training sessions following his re-election. The new Cornwall Council Administration has been formed with Rob Nolan as the Council's Chair. Lee Frost as the Leader of the Council and Adam Paynter as Deputy Leader. Planning applications received: PA25/02687 Shepherds Barn, Tinney Hall Farm, Lewannick, Launceston. The Parish Council resolved to support this application

PA25/03076 Ridgeview, Polyphant, Launceston. The Parish Council resolved to object to this planning application. PA25/03310 Pen-Inney Cottage, Lewannick Launceston. Application for tree works in a Tree Preservation Order to include removal of a Monterey Cypress. The Parish Council resolved to support this application.

PA25/01755 The Old Police House, Lewannick, Launceston. Extension to create first floor residential unit above existing private workshop/storage building and associated works including external access stair. The Parish Council resolved to object to this planning application. The Parish Council remains committed to pushing for a grade separated junction at Plusha and supports Councillor Parsons in this regard.
