The Parish Council resolved to support this application. PA25/01755 The Old Police House, Lewannick, Launceston. Extension to create first floor residential unit above existing private workshop/storage building and associated works including external access stair. The Parish Council resolved to object to this planning application. The Parish Council remains committed to pushing for a grade separated junction at Plusha and supports Councillor Parsons in this regard.
