The Parish Council met in Polyphant on Tuesday 17th June, we met at the play area to discuss the equipment and seating, we moved to the Green and discussed the fencing placed around an area of the green also the general condition of the trees.

The election of the Vice chair was carried out and Cllr Carole Newbery was elected. The Co-option of Parish Councillor, only one application was received from Karon McRae-Powell, Karon spoke of her reasons for wanting to join the Council. Karon was duly Co-opted onto the Council.

Cllr Parsons gave an update on proposed improvements on the Plusha junction and the collaboration between Cornwall Council and National Highways.

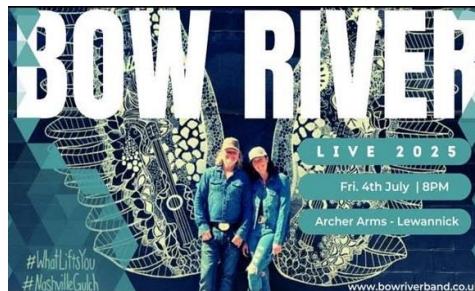
